Kenneth Ernest Beussink, age 57, of Cape Girardeau, MO, died Saturday, May 2, 2009, at St. Francis Medical Center in Cape Girardeau, Mo. He was born September 20, 1951 in Cape Girardeau the son of Ernest Henry and Irene Rosena Wubker Beussink. He and Donna Huey were married September 11, 1982 in Cape Girardeau. Beussink was a graduate of St. Mary's Grade School and Notre Dame High School. He attended John A. Logan College two years. He was a warehouse manager for Mid-America Distributing 10 years and previously had worked for Holiday Inn. Beussink was a member of St. Mary's Cathedral, Thomas A. Langen Assembly, Fourth Degree, and Knights of Columbus Council #1111 and was honored in 1996 as the Knight of the Year. Beussink was very active in Boy Scouts. He was an Eagle Scout and worked at Philmont Scout Ranch two summers during High School. He was a Tiger Cub Coach and Assistant Den Leader for Pack 8, Assistant Scout Master with Troop 5, Order of the Arrow Vigil Member, Unit Commissioner with Shawnee District, and District Committee Member a number of years. He received the District Award of Merit in 1998 and the Wood Badge in 2001. Survivors include his wife, Donna Beussink; son, Matthew Beussink; daughter, Kendra Beussink; and father, Ernest Beussink, all of Cape Girardeau. Other survivors are four brothers, Glen (Paulette) Beussink of Cape Girardeau, Mo.; Donald (Sheila) Beussink of Iowa City, Iowa; Edwin (Judy) Beussink of Milstadt, Ill.; Duane (Kari) Beussink of Cape Girardeau, Mo.; one sister, Elaine Martha (Tommy) Webb of Luling, Texas.
