Kenneth Edward Cantrell, Sr. (Ken or Kenny, to his friends), 77, of Cape Girardeau died October 16, 2024, at his home surrounded by family.

Kenny was born August 7, 1947, in Cape Girardeau, Missouri to Clarence and Mary Cantrell. He grew up in and eventually ran a business based initially out of Salcedo, Missouri, graduated high school in Sikeston, Missouri, and moved to Cape Girardeau when he attended Southeast Missouri State University.
