Kenneth Max Morgan, 93, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri passed away Friday, June 17, 2022 at the Lutheran Home.

He was born January 10, 1929 in De Graff, Kansas to Maurice Austin and Laura Ruth McMillan Morgan.

He and Mary Grove were married June 29, 1952, in El Dorado, Kansas. She preceded him in death on April 3, 2014.

Kenneth earned his bachelor of science degree in agricultural engineering from Kansas State in 1952. He enlisted in the Air Force after graduation and served his country from 1952 until July of 1956. After his service he worked for the soil conservation department of the U.S. government and became the area engineer in Southeast Missouri. He was a dedicated member of Bethany Baptist Church. He taught Sunday school for 65 consecutive years.
