Kristen Ashleigh Wilson, 37 of Cape Girardeau, passed away Wednesday, February 6, 2019 at 3:39 p.m. at her home surrounded by her family.

She was born May 21, 1981 in Sikeston, Missouri to George Dwight and Sheila Kay (Darby) White.

Kristen was a 1999 graduate of Charleston High School and a 2004 graduate of Southeast Missouri State University where she earned a bachelor's degree in computer science. She and Jacob Wilson were married October 23, 2005. She worked for AT&T for 15 years.

Kristen was diagnosed with stage 3 triple negative breast cancer in March of 2016. It metastasized to her bones and liver and she battled for 3 years and had numerous chemo and radiation treatments. She never gave up and she always managed to have a smile on her face.

Loving survivors include her father and step-mother, George Dwight (Carol) White of Perryville; mother, Sheila K. White of Bertrand; husband, Jacob Wilson of Cape Girardeau; daughter, Taylor Wilson of Cape Girardeau; brother, Ryan (Sheena) White of Columbia, Missouri; two step-brothers, Brian (Sarah) Moran and Jared Moran, both of Perryville; step niece, Sydney Moran; one niece, Rian Ashleigh White on the way.
