Lawanda "Chickie" Kaiser, 84, of Cape Girardeau died peacefully Saturday, June 4, 2011, at Chateau Girardeau Health Center. He preceded her in death on July 19, 2006. Chickie attended Cape Girardeau public schools and graduated from Southeast Missouri State University with bachelor and masters of science degrees in education. She taught in Sikeston, Mo., Kansas City and at William Woods University before spending the final 28 years of her career as a junior high school physical education teacher in Cape Girardeau.
