Linda Faye Harmon, 82, of Port St. Lucie, Florida (formerly Cedar Rapids, Iowa), passed away peacefully in the early morning hours of Tuesday, March 17, 2026, at A Touch of Class Adult Care home in Port St. Lucie.

She was born June 11, 1943, in Cape Girardeau, Missouri, to Raymond T. and Opal Pauline Sample Roth of Illmo, Missouri.

She and James Harmon, formerly from Chaffee, were married August 8, 1965 at Eisleben Lutheran Church in Illmo.

Linda lived her life with a deep and abiding devotion to the Lord which guided her in all things. Her faith was the foundation upon which she built a life filled with compassion, generosity and love. Whether through quiet moments at home or joyful gatherings, Linda found her greatest happiness in the presence of those she loved.
