



## Lloyd Norman Goehman

October 15, 1952 - September 15, 2016

Lloyd Norman Goehman, 63, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri died Thursday, September 15, 2016 at his home.

He was born October 15, 1952 in Cape Girardeau, MO to Loyd J. and Virginia E. Hudson Goehman.

He and Letricia L. "Trish" Lueder Goehman were married June 29, 1974 in Cape Girardeau, MO. She preceded him in death on February 7, 2005. Together they owned and operated Flora Creek Farms from 1985 until the present.

In the early 70's, Norman was a member of the Cape Girardeau Police Reserve, leaving there in 1974. He was later employed as a heavy equipment operator/truck driver for the Cape Special Road District for over 30 years, retiring in 2007.

He was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church- Egypt Mills, and was also a lifetime member of the Girl Scouts of America. He also helped to establish the East County Fire Protection District, where he currently served as a board member.

Survivors include David L. Goehman, son, of Cape Girardeau, MO and

Elizabeth J. ( Kenneth ) Wyatt, daughter, and Hunter Shane, grandson, of Monroe, Louisiana. Norman was an only child, but considered his brothers and sisters-in-law as his own.

He was preceded in death by his parents and wife.

Visitation will be from 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM on Sunday, September 18, 2016 at Ford & Sons Mt. Auburn Chapel and again Monday from 9:00 AM until service at Trinity Lutheran Church of Egypt Mills.

Burial will be at Trinity Lutheran Church Cemetery of Egypt Mills .

“ I worked with Trish at Nell Holcomb School for 12 years. Oh, she was a character! She was always cheerful and usually up to some kind of joke. She loved coming to my class to play with our classroom pets, guinea pigs, especially when they had babies. I remember every day hearing the jingle of her keys as she walked down the hall at 10:30 a.m. She'd always stop by for a morning hello. Shortly before she passed away, Trish stood in my classroom and talked about using some of the many sick and personal days she had to take time off to be with your grandson, Hunter. I'm not sure she ever got to do that. Trish was one of the first people I confided in that I was getting divorced. Not long after, she and Norman arrived at my house in Jackson with a stock trailer hooked up to their pickup, Kenny and Liz with their truck ( I believe Liz was about 9 months pregnant), and David with his truck. They spent the entire evening moving me to my new home out here in Egypt Mills. When we got to my new house, I told Norman the refrigerator (according to my measurements) was probably too tall to fit. As he pushed the frig in place under the cabinet (it fit perfectly....snug, but perfectly), Norman looked at me and said, "You've got angels." At that moment, I knew it to be true and their names were Trish and Norman. That's how Trish and Norman were...always ready to help someone.
