He was a Staff Sgt. with Company A, 381st Infantry Regiment, 96th Infantry Division "Deadeyes". He participated in the Division landing on Leyte in the Philippines on Oct. 20 1944, He was also in the first wave when the 96th Division landed on Okinawa on April 1, 1945, He was awarded the Good Conduct Medal, Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Ribbon with two Bronze Service Stars, Philippine Liberation Ribbon with two Bronze Stars, combat Infantry Badge, American Theater Campaign Ribbon, World War II Victory Medal, Bronze Service Arrowhead, Expert Infantry Badge and two Overseas Service Bars. He was a member of American Legion Post 158, Jackson, Missouri Following his discharge he was employed by Florsheim Shoe Company until retirement, He was a member of the Thebes Grade School Board and a member of the Thebes Town Board, He enjoyed hunting, fishing, gardening and going on nature walks with family members. He was an avid Cardinal Fan.
