October 23, 1931 - October 19, 2020

Margie Marie Reimold, daughter of Robert and Laura Feuerhahn Grossheider, was born October 24, 1931 at Gordonville, MO.

She became a member of God's family through the washing of Holy Baptism on November 8, 1931, and made a public confession of her faith in Jesus Christ as her Savior at her confirmation at Zion Lutheran Church, Gordonville, on March 25, 1945.

A graduate of Concordia Teachers College at River Forest, IL, Margie taught at Lutheran Elementary Schools in Monte Vista, Colorado; Melrose Park, Illinois; Perryville, Missouri; and Memphis Tennessee.
