Dr. Mark Hosler, respected physician and beloved father and grandfather, passed away in his home on July 31st, 2020.

He was born in Carrollton, Missouri on February 1st, 1947, and lived throughout Missouri during his early life.

A Phi Beta Kappa graduate of the University of Missouri and a graduate of Washington University School of Medicine, he practiced medicine in Cape Girardeau for 32 years. He was well known in the community as extremely generous, a devout man of faith, and an avid runner, who still holds age group state records for 5K runs.
