Mary Belle Headrick, 91, of Jackson, Missouri died Monday, February 25, 2019 at The Arbors in Cape Girardeau.

She was born January 17, 1928 at the family farm between Jackson and Oak Ridge to James Shelton and Daisy Cowan Godwin.

She and Ralph Headrick were married July 17, 1948 at Jackson, Missouri. He preceded her in death on May 15, 2014.
