Mary C. Kasten, 96, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri died Saturday, October 12, 2024 at her residence.

She was born June 6, 1928 in Matthews, MO to Clarence A. and Ruth (Hill) Critchlow.

She and Melvin Charles Kasten were married June 19, 1949 in Matthews, MO.

Mary Kasten was an amazing woman. She was a Cape Public School Board member for 21 years, President of the Missouri School Board Association, served on the SEMO Board of Regents, and Missouri State Representative for 19 years.
