Another memory is of visiting you in hospital in Memphis. You were admitted for heart problems. I had tachycardia while driving to see you. When I walked into your room Aunt Ella asked me if I was alright. When I told her I was having tachycardia she told me to lie down on the cot they had brought into your room for her to sleep on. She called your nurse to come check on me. I called Don to see what I should do. He told me to ask nurse what my pulse was. She said it was so fast she couldn’t count it. The he said ask her what meds you had on your bedside table. He told me to take one of your beta blockers, wait 15 minutes and if it hadn’t slowed down, go to ER. It returned to normal rhythm within 15 minutes. You may have saved my life that day, Cuz. I know you’re enjoying your new heart in heaven!
