Morris Van Winkle, 79, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri, passed away Sunday, March 20, 2016 at Saint Francis Medical Center in Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

He was born Sunday, March 14, 1937 in Chalmers, Illinois to Moses E. and Ella M. (Johnson) Van Winkle.
