Oltha Mae Helsley Fesler, 89, died on Saturday, June 27, 2009, at Southeast Missouri Hospital in Cape Girardeau, Missouri. She was born in Essex, MO., December 8, 1919 to Sherman Helsley and Iva Miles Helsley. She was married to Carney Fesler in Essex, MO. on May 3, 1952 who survives. Oltha graduated from the high school in Essex, Mo. She was postmaster during the World War II years and later worked for the former Missouri Utilities Co. in Dexter, Mo.
