Paul Ronald "Ronnie" Walker, 75, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri died Wednesday, February 20, 2019 at Southeast Hospital.

Born April 17, 1943 in Medford, Oregon to Paul Edward and Mary Margaret Morton Walker, Paul was a graduate of College High and attended Southeast Missouri State University.

A sales representative with the Southeast Missourian for more than 25 years he also served as advertising manager.
