Raymond T. Roth, 94, of Cape Girardeau, MO, passed away Friday, December 24, 2010 at Life Care Center of Cape Girardeau in Cape Girardeau, MO. Mr. Roth, a long time Illmo businessman was born Oct, 9, 1916 in Illmo, MO., the son of Martin Frederick and Elsie E. Lueddecke Roth. He graduated from Illmo High School in 1934 and was the oldest surviving graduate. He attended Southeast Teachers College. He joined the Army National Guard in 1934 and served in the Army - Air Corps during World War II. He retired from the National Guard with the rank of Lt. Colonel. After returning from the war he started Roth Hardware in Illmo in 1947 which is still owned and operated by family. On July 31, 1940 he married the former Opal P. Sample who preceded him in death on June 7, 1998. In August 1999 he married the former Dorothy Davis who survives. He is survived by two daughters Peggy R. Brooks (Norman) of Scott City and Linda Harmon (James) of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, three granddaughters, three great granddaughters, a step daughter, Gina Asberry and stepson Bill Busche and two sisters in law. In addition to his wife and parents he was preceded in death by his son, Dr. Steven F. Roth and three brothers. He was baptized and confirmed in Eisleben Lutheran Church in Illmo and was presently a member of Good Shepherd Lutheran Chapel. Visitation will be from 4 to 8PM on Tuesday, Dec. 28, 2010 at Ford & Sons Mt. Auburn Chapel. Funeral service will be on Wednesday, Dec. 29, 2010 at 10:00AM at the chapel with Rev. Barry Pfanstiel of Good Shepherd officiating. Burial will be in Cape County
