Rebecca Eleanor Atkins, 67, of Cape Girardeau passed away Thursday, March 18, 2021, at Saint Francis Medical Center in Cape Girardeau. She was born Nov. 1, 1953, in Ottawa, Kansas, to John and Rachael Young.

When her family moved to Cape Girardeau in 1968, she attended Central High School and graduated in 1971. She then attended Southeast Missouri State University and William Jewell College, where she met her future husband.

She and Carl David Atkins were married in Cape Girardeau in 1974. She and David were the parents of three daughters, Crystal Monahan, Carly Winters and Jessica Atkins.

Rebecca worked many years in the restaurant management industry and was also an AID board member at VIP Industries.

She was a faithful member of the Assemblies of Yahweh (Bethel, Pennsylvania) for 30 years.

A devoted mother and grandmother, she helped homeschool two of her grandchildren. She is remembered by many for her sweet demeanor and thoughtful acts of kindness.
