Rev. William H. Marshall, 84, of Benton, MO died Thursday, June 19, 2014 at his home surrounded by family. He was born July 21, 1929 in Manila, AR to the late Edward J. and Sally B. (Hall) Marshall. He and Loretta Tate were married June 10, 1949 at Burdette, Arkansas. Rev. Marshall pastored in Chaffee, MO for more than 45 years. He was the pastor at the Christian Mission Church in Benton, MO at the time of his passing, where he had been ministering since 2001. Other places he has pastored over the years include; Milligan Ridge, AR, Childers, AR, and Steele, MO. Rev. Marshall, along with family and volunteers, operated the Bethesda Fellowship in Cape Girardeau, which was a food and clothing pantry ministry. Other ministries he enjoyed over the years included TV programs on the TCT network. He had participated in "Ask the Pastor" for years until the time of his passing. Rev. Marshall was able to travel to Israel 4 times, Hawaii, Nottingham, England, St. Petersburg, Russia, Ireland, saw the Pope in Rome and took a Christian cruise to Bahamas. He and his wife, Loretta, were a great ministry team. They were blessed to be able to celebrate their 65th wedding anniversary together June 10th. Survivors include his wife, Loretta Marshall of Benton, MO; son, Danny Lynn Marshall of Knoxville, TN; daughters, Teresa Darlene Williams of Benton, MO, Sarah J. Gregory of Benton, MO; brothers, Rev.
