Robert A. Schott, 71, of Cape Girardeau, died Thursday, November 18, 2010 at St. Francis Medical Center. Robert was a graduate of Cape Girardeau Catholic High School. He attended St. Louis University two years and Rankin Technical College in St. Louis two years. In 1959 he and his family started Schott Electrical Distributors, Inc. He was the sole proprietor from 1982 until the business was sold in 1998. Robert was a member of St. Mary Cathedral where he served as an usher; Knights of Columbus Council # 1111 and served as Past Grand Knight; Thomas A.
