Robert J. "Bob" Polack, Sr. died Thursday, April 19th, 2012, at his home in Cape Girardeau. He was born December 28, 1926, in Cape Girardeau to Edward A. and Anita Brune Polack. He and Dorothy V. Gillespie were married April 18, 1953 in Cape Girardeau. She survives. Bob was a 1944 graduate of Central High School and attended Southeast Missouri State University. He was a World War II veteran serving in the Pacific Theatre. He was a founding member of Good Shepherd Lutheran Chapel, and was instrumental in the construction of the church building on Cape Rock Drive. He was also a member of V.F.W. Post 3838. He was an owner of E. A. Polack Plumbing and Heating. Survivors include his wife, Dorothy, of Cape Girardeau; a sister, Helen Polack of Cape Girardeau; two sons, Robert J. Polack, Jr. and his wife, Joy Bell, of Cape Girardeau and John Edward Polack of Cape Girardeau; and a grandson, John Polack of Chicago. He was preceded in death by his brother, Edward Polack, and two sisters, Marie Harshaw and Ruth McCain. Visitation will be Saturday, April 21, 2012, 1 PM until service time at Ford & Sons Mt. Auburn Funeral Home. Funeral service will be at 2 PM at the funeral home. Entombment will follow at Cape County Memorial Park Mausoleum. Full military rites will be provided by V.F.W.
