Robert Elias Jones, 81, of Cape Girardeau died Monday, March 22, 2010 at the Lutheran Home. He was born March 22, 1929 in Berea, Kentucky. The son of John Roy and Montie Raye (Davis) Jones. Mr. Jones was a member of Grace United Methodist Church and served as District Treasurer for 14 years, Financial Chairman, Sunday School Superintendant and Sunday School Teacher. He was a part owner in Kingsway Roller Skating rinks in Cape Girardeau, Paducah and Hopkinsville, Kentucky. He was honored by Governor Brown of Kentucky as a Kentucky Colonel.
