



## Roberta Fay Robb Jean

Roberta Fay Robb Jean, 93, of Cape Girardeau passed away Monday, Aug. 1, 2022, at The Chateau Girardeau. She was born Aug. 7, 1928, in LaHarpe, Kansas, to the late Harley and Mary Etta Harclerode Robb.

She grew up with her brothers and sisters helping her parents on the farm. Roberta graduated from Humboldt High School in Humboldt, Kansas, in 1946, and Iola Junior College in Iola, Kansas, in 1949. She worked for a doctor, drug store and bank before marrying and having children.

She was a member of Lynwood Baptist Church after moving to Cape Girardeau. Roberta enjoyed sewing, quilting, reading, cooking, camping, fishing and gardening.
