Roger Duncan Scott, 86, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri died Friday, December 9, 2016, at his home.

He was born December 10, 1929, in LaGrange, IL, to Wilfred A. and Henrietta G. (Cheney) Scott. On February 19, 1955, he married Eunice M. Heinrich.

After high school graduation, he began working for the family business, LaGrange Floral Shop. He also served in the Army National Guard.
