Ronald C. Roth, 80, of Cape Girardeau died Saturday, August 29, 2020 at Saint Francis Medical Center.

He was born February 7, 1940 in Saint Louis, Missouri to Walter and Henrietta Reiter Roth.

Ron received a Bachelors in Education from Missouri University in Columbia and a Masters in Mental Health from Southeast Missouri State University.
