Rosemary Craig Logan, 84, of Cape Girardeau, MO, died Thursday, March 14, 2013 at Southeast Missouri Hospital. She was born July 11, 1928 in Illmo, MO to John J. and Mattie M. Morrow Craig . Rosamary graduated from Cape Central High School , attended Southeast Missouri State University and graduated from Missouri University with a Bachelor's Degree in French. She was a member of the French National Honor Society and Alpha Phi Sorority. She couldn't enter medical school due to illness but joined her father in his real estate bussiness. She and James W. Logan were married in 1951 at Cape Girardeau. Together they were owner and operator of Logan's Nursery and Landscaping from 1960 to 1974. Rosemary and Jim started plans with others to renew the famous May Greene Garden. She started her third career as a travel agent with Perry Travel, managing Gulliver's Travel and help start Destinations Unlimited, retiring in 1994. Rosemary was a member of First Presbyterian Church, Southeast Health Auxiliary, the first Food Pantry and Meals on Wheels. Survivors include her husband - James W. Logan of the home. Several cousins and close friends also mourn her passing. She was preceded in death by her parents and son, Craig Logan in 2006. Visitation will be from 9:00 AM to 12:30 PM on Sunday, March 17, 2013 at Ford & Sons Mt. Auburn Chapel and again from 1:00 PM until service time at 2:00 PM at First Presbyterain Church in Cape Girardeau. Funeral will be at 2:00 PM Sunday, March 17, 2013 at First Presbyterian Church with the Rev. Bill Vincent officiating. Burial will follow at Cape County Memorial Park Cemetery.
