Roy L. Beck, 88, of Cape Girardeau, formerly of Sikeston, passed away Thursday, Feb. 10, 2022, at Southeast Hospital.

He was born Nov. 28, 1933, in Sikeston, Missouri to the late Roy M. and Ethel M. Johnson Beck.

Roy and Beverly Andres were married January 8, 1955, in Sikeston.

Roy graduated from Sikeston High School in 1951, Draughn's Business College, Paducah, KY in 1953. He attended classes at Southeast Missouri State University and Central Missouri State College, Independence, Missouri. He enlisted in the Missouri National Guard in July of 1953 and received an honorable discharge from the US Army Reserve July 31, 1961.

Roy worked as marketing manager for Southwestern Bell Telephone Co., now AT&T for 25 years. He was a member of the Telephone Pioneers of America. After retiring Roy was engaged in insurance, real estate, and private business for several years.

Roy was a charter member of Murray Lane Baptist Church in Sikeston. He was among the first Deacons ordained at the church and served from 1959-1963. He was currently a member at Lynwood Baptist Church in Cape where he served in numerous capacities.
