Roy Glastetter, 74, of Cape Girardeau died Tuesday, January 28, 2014 at Southeast Missouri Hospital. He was born March 18, 1939 in New Hamburg, Mo. to Edward and Coletta Glaus Glastetter. He and Julia Marie Phelps were married April 20, 1963 at Cape Girardeau, Mo. She preceded him in death February 28, 2007. Roy served in the National Guard. He started his grocery career with A&P, followed by his position as Director of Retail Services for Wetterau in Scott City. He then became a co-owner/operator of Portageville I.G.A. Inc., which included five I.G.A. stores with locations in Brownsville and Martin, Tenn. and Portageville, New Madrid, and Charleston, Mo. He was also part owner/operator of Dairy Queens in Sikeston and Charleston. He retired from Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. in May 2007. Survivors include two sons, Bob Glastetter (Jacki) of Cape Girardeau, Steve Glastetter of Jackson, Mo.; daughter, Lisa Glastetter of Cape Girardeau; brother, Gary Glastetter of Oran, Mo.; sister, Marcella Kapfer of Cape Girardeau; two grandsons, Scott Glastetter of Jackson, Joey Ashley of Indianapolis, Ind.
