Sellavene "Ceil" Watkins Law, age 87, passed away peacefully Wednesday, June 5, 2024 at Monticello House in Jackson. Ceil worked as a secretary for several local businesses and retired after serving as the pastor's secretary at First Baptist Church in Jackson.

Ceil spent many hours working in the church library. During her retirement years, Ceil volunteered in her community and spent time traveling, reading, quilting, and spending time with family and friends. Ceil and Lloyd enjoyed attending their grandchildren and great grandchildren's special events. Lloyd and Ceil remained married for 63 years until Lloyd passed away in 2018.

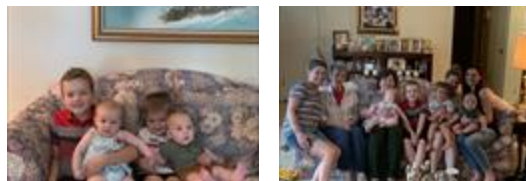
