Shirley Jean Sander Dippold, 94, of Cape Girardeau, died October 30, 2021, at the Lutheran Home.

She was born October 27, 1927, to Charles Henry and Olga Minnie Meyer Sander in Jackson, Missouri. She graduated from Jackson High School and attended Southeast Missouri State Teachers College until her husband returned from service in the U. S. Navy.
