



## Stanley Wayne Mouser

Stanley Wayne Mouser, 70, of McClure, Illinois died Sunday, December 25, 2016 at Saint Francis Medical Center in Cape Girardeau.

He was born December 11, 1946 in Sikeston, Missouri to Otis B. and Daisy Roxana Stephens Mouser.

He and Linda Lucas were married April 9, 1983 at Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

Stanley was a graduate of Shawnee High School.
