Thomas M. Hogan, 89, of Cape Girardeau died Thursday, April 8, 2010, at Life Care Center of Cape Girardeau. He was born May 9, 1920, in Cairo, Ill., son of Thomas W. and Cleo L. Oglesby Hogan. He and Arietta Spurlock Hogan were married Dec. 31, 1949, in Clay County, Ark. She preceded him in death Feb. 6, 1998. Mr. Hogan was an auto mechanic for Ford Groves Motor Co. and later was owner/operator of Hogan Phillips 66 on Kingshighway for 21 years, retiring in 1990. He was a former member of the Cape Girardeau Chamber of Commerce.
