Timothy M. Briner, 60, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri passed away Wednesday January 30, 2019 at Saint Francis Medical Center.

He was born July 10, 1958 in Saint Joseph, Missouri to Marvin E. and Shirley J. (Glidewell) Briner. Tim was a graduate of Savannah High School, Savannah, Missouri.

He and Janelle M. Smith were married June 16, 1979 in Auburn, Nebraska. Unto that union, three children were born. He served in the U.S. Army as a Combat Medic and deployed to Kuwait and Iraq during Operation Desert Storm/Desert Shield. After his honorable discharge, Tim went on and became a graduate of Southeast Hospital College of Nursing and Health. He most recently worked as a RN Medical Case Reviewer for Evicore Healthcare. 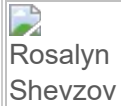
