Vera Lohmann, 95, of Cape Girardeau, passed away Saturday, January 28, 2017 at the Lutheran Home in Cape Girardeau.

She was born August 29, 1921 in Kelso, Missouri to the late Killian and Frances (Ziegler) Felter.

She was married to Clarence Anton Lohmann on November 18, 1939. He passed away on October 12, 2008.
