



Vergie Bee Templeton

February 12, 1919 - November 9, 2015

Vergie Bee Seabaugh Templeton, 96, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri, went home to be with the Lord on Monday, November 9, 2015, at Saint Francis Medical Center where she was surrounded by family and love.

She was born February 12, 1919, in Sedgewickville, Missouri, to Eli Seabaugh and Evelyn Niswonger Seabaugh.

Vergie attended school in Jackson, Missouri. After school, she went to work at the Eli Walker Pants Factory in Old Illmo. It was during this time she met her husband, Charles Poe Templeton. The two were married on January 11, 1941 in Greenville, Missouri.

During the rest of her time in Cape Girardeau, Vergie was a home maker. In her free time she volunteered at the Missouri Veterans Home where she served over eight thousand hours. Vergie was also an active member of the American Legion Auxiliary, V.F.W., and Centenary Methodist Church.

Vergie is survived by her son, Robert (Jodi) Templeton; the daughter of her heart, Loretta Land; two grandchildren, Suzanne (Derek) Hiatt and David (Kristi) Templeton; and four great-grandchildren, Hunter and Landen Hiatt, Emma Ann and Molly Kate Templeton.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Charles Poe Templeton; three

sisters, Myrtle Allen, Jettie Hamm, and Marguerite Smith; one brother, Truman Seabaugh; and a grandson, Drew Michael Templeton.

Visitation will be at 11 am on Thursday, November 12, 2015, at Ford and Sons Funeral Home on Mount Auburn Road in Cape Girardeau. The funeral service will follow visitation at 12 pm with Rev Jim Sanderson and Rev Dave Conley officiating. Burial will be at Lorimer Cemetery in Cape Girardeau.
