Vernon John Compas, 88, of Cape Girardeau died peacefully on Saturday, Dec. 9, 2023, at Chateau Girardeau in Cape Girardeau, MO.

He was born July 16, 1935, in Cape Girardeau, Missouri, to Leo and Clara Diebold Compas.

Vernon married the love of his life, Elwanda Macke, June 20, 1959. He was a member of St. Mary's Cathedral in Cape Girardeau. Vernon was a lifetime member of the Knights of Columbus Council 1111 and of the Missouri Retired Teachers Association.

He taught for 33 years - physical education at Franklin school, Cape Girardeau, MO and early in his career at Thebes Elementary School and May Green. He also coached basketball.

When Vernon retired from teaching, he and Elwanda worked for Day Transfer Moving Company packing up houses for moving military members. He loved to fish and hunt and passed that onto his sons. Vernon and Elwanda spent their retirement years going on cruises all over the world.
