Wayne T. Hanebrink died in St. Louis on July 22, 2022, at the age of 83.

He is survived by Annaliesa, his wife of 61 years, son Paul, and brother Gary.

Born in Cape Girardeau, Wayne graduated from Central High School in 1956. After a year of college at Southeast Missouri State College, as the university was called then, he moved with his parents to Carbondale, Illinois, where he earned his B.A. and M.A. degrees from Southern Illinois University, Carbondale.

He studied the history of modern Britain at Washington University in St. Louis, receiving his doctorate in 1973. He then embarked on a career in university administration at Washington University, rising to the post of associate dean of the College of Arts and Sciences.

After his retirement he remained involved with the university, serving as president of the Society of Professors Emeriti and as an English-language tutor for international students.

Wayne's cremated remains will be buried in May 2023 at New Lorimier Cemetery in a private ceremony.
