William Hugh Burkheimer, 92, of Cape Girardeau died Saturday, Jan. 30, 2010, at Southeast Missouri Hospital. He was born Dec. 27, 1917, in Altoona, Pa., son of William Snider and Grace Anna Wogan Burkheimer. He and Virginia Sue McMillan were married Aug. 2, 1944, at Tulare, Calif. She preceded him in death on June 3, 2002. Burkheimer served as a glider pilot in the U.S. Air Force during World War II in New Guinea and Australia. He was later a lieutenant colonel in the Air Force Reserves. He was a member of First Presbyterian Church, where he was a deacon and served on the building committee.
