September 9, 1938 - February 4, 2022

William "Larry" McKinney, 83, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri died Friday, February 4, 2022 at his home.

He was born September 9, 1938 in Tuscaloosa, Alabama to William and Lena Ruth Butler McKinney.

He and Carole Ann Urhahn were married April 12, 1959 in Cape Girardeau.

Larry was a graduate of Cape Central High School where he played on the 1954 Championship baseball team. In 2019, he served as the assistant coach to Zack Walton for Jackson's 2019 MSHSAA Golf Championship. He was also a longtime golf instructor.

He served in the Marines.

He worked for Crites & Sailer Construction Co., operated Larry McKinney Cleaning Service and owned a full service car wash.

He was a member of Lynwood Baptist Church.

He was preceded in death by his parents; and a brother, David.
